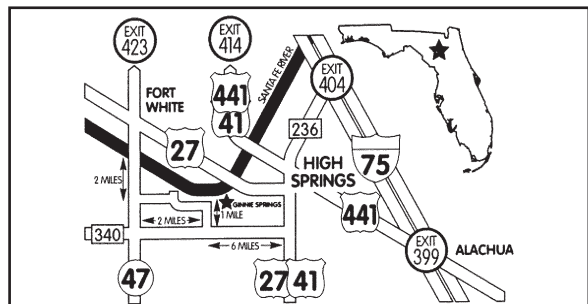

## Deposit Policy

**Weekend reservations require 2-night minimum stay and must include both Friday and Saturday night.** Reservations cancelled 3 days or more prior to arrival will receive a refund less a cancellation fee. \$10 per site for Electric and Water or \$50 for Cottage. Reservations cancelled within the 3-day period will forfeit the deposit; otherwise a 3-day notice will be required to reschedule a reservation.

All rescheduled reservations must be made and deposits used no later than December 15th of that year. Sorry, no refunds due to weather.

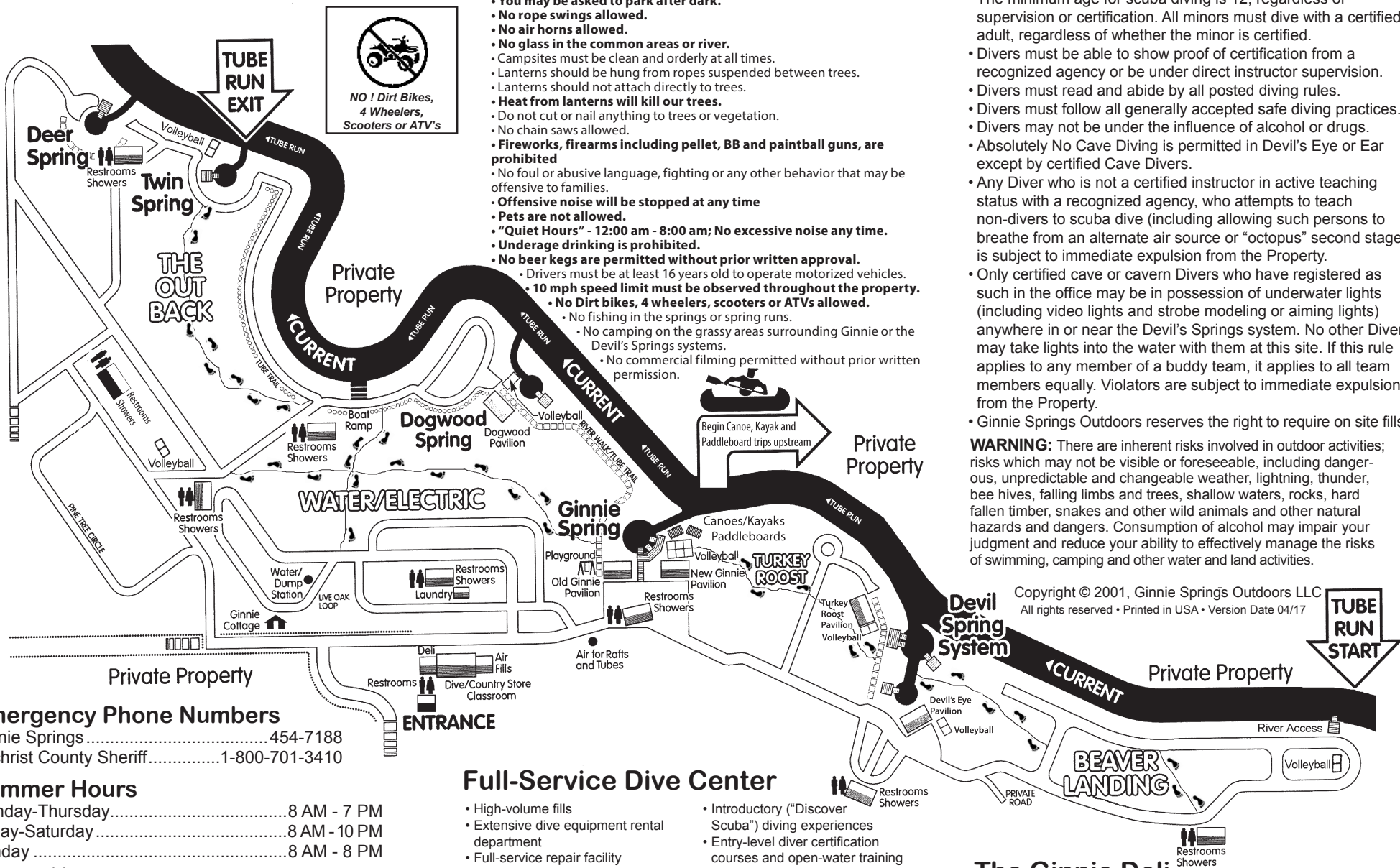
- Over 200 acres of wilderness camping

## Ginnie Springs Rules

Ginnie Springs is private property. Failure to abide by these Rules may, at the discretion of Ginnie Springs personnel, result in expulsion without refund. Persons failing to pay entrance or camping fees, who re-enter the Property after expulsion, or who refuse to leave when asked, will be considered trespassers and subject to arrest.

## General Rules Important Please Read

- Children under 12 require adult supervision at all times.
- Swim at your own risk. No lifeguards on duty.
- No diving or jumping from decks, banks or trees.
- No beer Bongs or Funnels.
- No Jet Skis.
- No riding on exteriors of vehicle.
- No excessive alcohol consumption.
- You may be asked to park after dark.
- No rope swings allowed.
- No air horns allowed.
- No glass in the common areas or river.
- Campsites must be clean and orderly at all times.
- Lanterns should be hung from ropes suspended between trees.
- Lanterns should not attach directly to trees.
- Heat from lanterns will kill our trees.
- Do not cut or nail anything to trees or vegetation.
- No chain saws allowed.
- Fireworks, firearms including pellet, BB and paintball guns, are prohibited
- No foul or abusive language, fighting or any other behavior that may be offensive to families.
- Offensive noise will be stopped at any time
- Pets are not allowed.
- "Quiet Hours" - 12:00 am - 8:00 am; No excessive noise any time.
- Underage drinking is prohibited.
- No beer kegs are permitted without prior written approval.
  - Drivers must be at least 16 years old to operate motorized vehicles.
  - 10 mph speed limit must be observed throughout the property.
  - No Dirt bikes, 4 wheelers, scooters or ATVs allowed.
- No fishing in the springs or spring runs.
- No camping on the grassy areas surrounding Ginnie or the Devil's Springs systems.
- No commercial filming permitted without prior written permission.



## Scuba Diving Rules

- All Divers must register at the office, pay applicable diving fees and sign a waiver/release form (minor's forms require the signature of a custodial, parent or legal guardian; if a custodial, parent or legal guardian will not be accompanying the minor to Ginnie Springs, the parent or guardian must have his or her signature notarized).
- The minimum age for scuba diving is 12, regardless of supervision or certification. All minors must dive with a certified adult, regardless of whether the minor is certified.
- Divers must be able to show proof of certification from a recognized agency or be under direct instructor supervision.
- Divers must read and abide by all posted diving rules.
- Divers must follow all generally accepted safe diving practices.
- Divers may not be under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- Absolutely No Cave Diving is permitted in Devil's Eye or Ear except by certified Cave Divers.
- Any Diver who is not a certified instructor in active teaching status with a recognized agency, who attempts to teach non-divers to scuba dive (including allowing such persons to breathe from an alternate air source or "octopus" second stage) is subject to immediate expulsion from the Property.
- Only certified cave or cavern Divers who have registered as such in the office may be in possession of underwater lights (including video lights and strobe modeling or aiming lights) anywhere in or near the Devil's Springs system. No other Divers may take lights into the water with them at this site. If this rule applies to any member of a buddy team, it applies to all team members equally. Violators are subject to immediate expulsion from the Property.
- Ginnie Springs Outdoors reserves the right to require on site fills.

**WARNING:** There are inherent risks involved in outdoor activities; risks which may not be visible or foreseeable, including dangerous, unpredictable and changeable weather, lightning, thunder, bee hives, falling limbs and trees, shallow waters, rocks, hard fallen timber, snakes and other wild animals and other natural hazards and dangers. Consumption of alcohol may impair your judgment and reduce your ability to effectively manage the risks of swimming, camping and other water and land activities.
