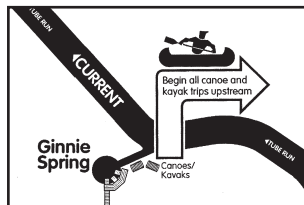
• **No Pickup service provided.** You must go UPSTREAM against the current. You will not be picked up if you choose to go downstream.

• Electric and Water site reservations require a 2-night minimum stay (March-September).

• All camping and Electric & Water fees are collected at the time of reservation

• Some major holidays require a 3-night minimum stay. Holiday rates apply.

• There is a \$15 cancellation fee per site and \$50 for the cottage.

• There is a \$10 rescheduling fee.

• All cancellations/reschedules must be done at least 48 hours prior to your arrival date.

• Cancellations made less than 48 hours prior to arrival date will forfeit the first night's camp fee(s) and electric & water fee(s). The remaining balance, if any, will be refunded.

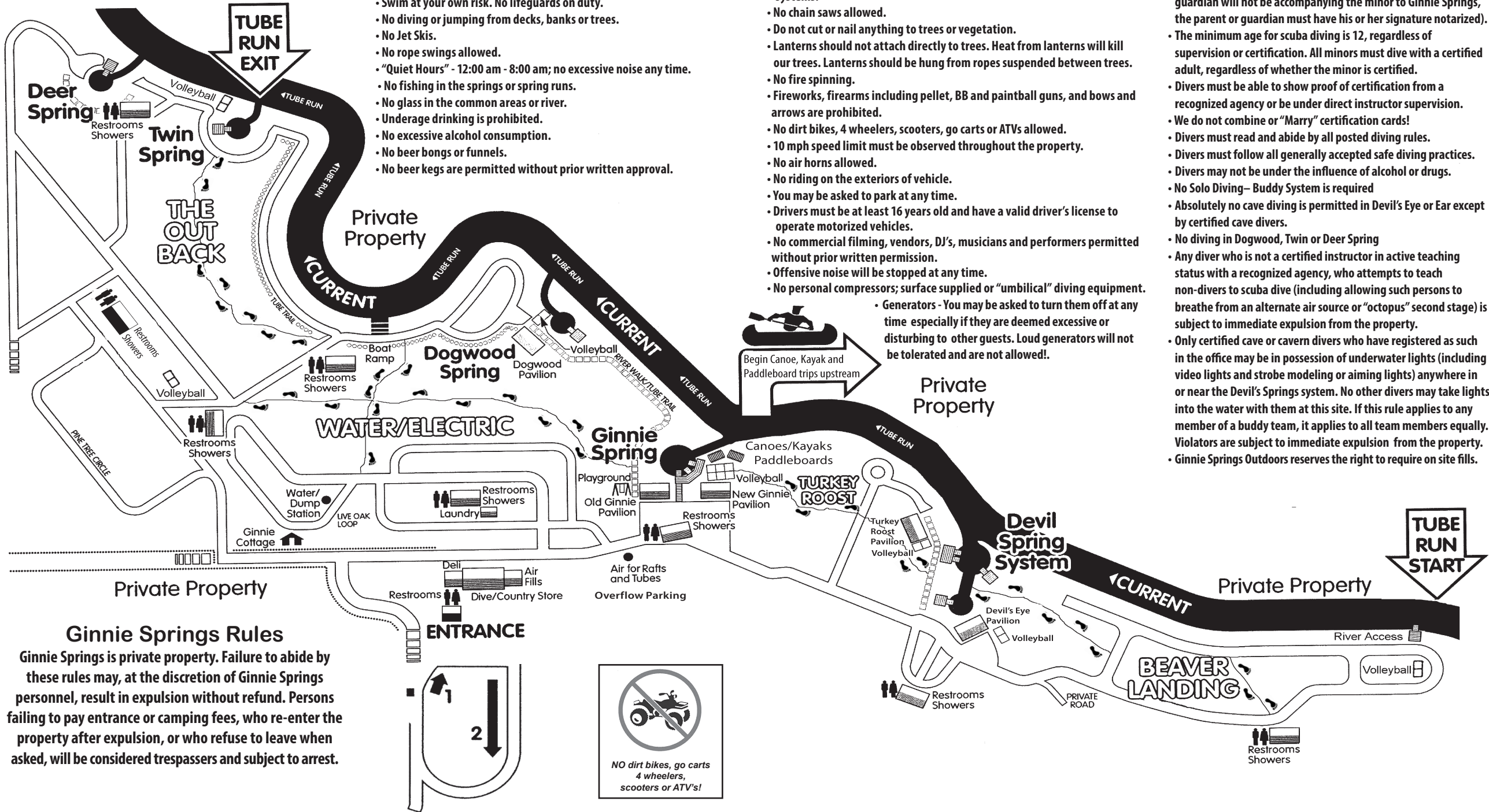
General Rules Important Please Read

- No Pets allowed!
- Children under 12 require adult supervision at all times.
- Swim at your own risk. No lifeguards on duty.
- No diving or jumping from decks, banks or trees.
- No Jet Skis.
- No rope swings allowed.
- "Quiet Hours" - 12:00 am - 8:00 am; no excessive noise any time.
- No fishing in the springs or spring runs.
- No glass in the common areas or river.
- Underage drinking is prohibited.
- No excessive alcohol consumption.
- No beer bong or funnels.
- No beer kegs are permitted without prior written approval.

- No foul or abusive language, fighting or any other behavior that may be offensive to other guests.
- Campsites must be clean and orderly at all times.
- No camping on the grassy areas surrounding Ginnie or the Devil's Springs systems.
- No chain saws allowed.
- Do not cut or nail anything to trees or vegetation.
- Lanterns should not attach directly to trees. Heat from lanterns will kill our trees. Lanterns should be hung from ropes suspended between trees.
- No fire spinning.
- Fireworks, firearms including pellet, BB and paintball guns, and bows and arrows are prohibited.
- No dirt bikes, 4 wheelers, scooters, go carts or ATVs allowed.
- 10 mph speed limit must be observed throughout the property.
- No air horns allowed.
- No riding on the exteriors of vehicle.
- You may be asked to park at any time.
- Drivers must be at least 16 years old and have a valid driver's license to operate motorized vehicles.
- No commercial filming, vendors, DJ's, musicians and performers permitted without prior written permission.
- Offensive noise will be stopped at any time.
- No personal compressors; surface supplied or "umbilical" diving equipment.
- Generators - You may be asked to turn them off at any time especially if they are deemed excessive or disturbing to other guests. Loud generators will not be tolerated and are not allowed!

Scuba Diving Rules

- All divers must register at the office, pay applicable diving fees and sign a waiver/release form (minor's forms require the signature of a custodial, parent or legal guardian; if a custodial, parent or legal guardian will not be accompanying the minor to Ginnie Springs, the parent or guardian must have his or her signature notarized).
- The minimum age for scuba diving is 12, regardless of supervision or certification. All minors must dive with a certified adult, regardless of whether the minor is certified.
- Divers must be able to show proof of certification from a recognized agency or be under direct instructor supervision.
- We do not combine or "Marry" certification cards!
- Divers must read and abide by all posted diving rules.
- Divers must follow all generally accepted safe diving practices.
- Divers may not be under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- No Solo Diving- Buddy System is required
- Absolutely no cave diving is permitted in Devil's Eye or Ear except by certified cave divers.
- No diving in Dogwood, Twin or Deer Spring
- Any diver who is not a certified instructor in active teaching status with a recognized agency, who attempts to teach non-divers to scuba dive (including allowing such persons to breathe from an alternate air source or "octopus" second stage) is subject to immediate expulsion from the property.
- Only certified cave or cavern divers who have registered as such in the office may be in possession of underwater lights (including video lights and strobe modeling or aiming lights) anywhere in or near the Devil's Springs system. No other divers may take lights into the water with them at this site. If this rule applies to any member of a buddy team, it applies to all team members equally. Violators are subject to immediate expulsion from the property.
- Ginnie Springs Outdoors reserves the right to require on site fills.



Ginnie Springs Rules

Ginnie Springs is private property. Failure to abide by these rules may, at the discretion of Ginnie Springs personnel, result in expulsion without refund. Persons failing to pay entrance or camping fees, who re-enter the property after expulsion, or who refuse to leave when asked, will be considered trespassers and subject to arrest.
